Introduction to Vietnam

Although many westerners might still view Vietnam through the lens of history and war, in reality the country is an oasis of harmony and peace; offering captivating natural beauty and tranquil villages. Its highlands and rainforests continue to yield new species and offer an abundance of exotic wildlife. The tropical islands and beaches are among the finest in the Asia-Pacific region. Decades have passed since Vietnam was officially united and during this time the country has done a remarkable job of healing its wounds. Today, this stunningly beautiful land is an outstanding travel destination that offers something for everyone – be it history, cultural heritage, or exploring the country's abundant exotic fauna and flora.



ITINERARY

Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

Upon arrival at Hanoi - Noi Bai airport, look for your tour guide holding a signboard with your name on it. Then meet with your driver for a 45-min private transfer to your hotel in the center. Hanoi is Vietnam's modern-day capital. Classic, colonial architecture, distinctive cuisine, and a millennium of history and culture give Hanoi her elegance.

Notes:

- The regular check-in hotel is 15:00. Early check-in is not included and subject to the availability.

Day 2: Hanoi

Breakfast at hotel.

Visit Ba Dinh Square where silent sentries guard the marble mausoleum in which Ho Chi Minh lies in state. Subject to opening hours, the interior of the mausoleum may be visited (closed Monday & Friday weekly and all afternoons). Continue to the modest stilted wooden bungalow where Uncle Ho lived and worked, before visiting Ho Chi Minh Museum. Dedicated to the father of the country, the museum chronicles the evolution of Vietnamese independence. Continue to the One Pillar Pagoda, a Buddhist pagoda with a history steeped in folklore. Continue to explore one of the city's many interesting museums- choose from Vietnamese Women Museum or Hoa Lo Prison or Fine Arts Museum, depending on your personal interests (please discuss with your tour guide at destination). Lunch is at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, stroll through Temple of Literature, a serene retreat from the busy streets outside. Built in 1070 and dedicated to Confucius, it became Vietnam's first university. Cap off the trip with a walk through the labyrinthine alleyways of the Old Quarters. This oldest continuously developed area of Hanoi was once an important centre of commerce where goods were sold on the street name of a particular guild. Stop at a roadside coffee shop, mingle with the locals and enjoy the daily life passing while tasting coffee.

- The Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is closed Monday & Friday weekly and all afternoons. Otherwise, outside visit only.

Day 3: Hanoi – Halong Bay

Breakfast at hotel.

09:00 Take a 2.5-hour drive from Hanoi to Tuan Chau jetty for your Halong overnight trip. Enjoy the UNESCO World Heritage site with a dense concentration of limestone islands, caves and grottos, and magnificent scenery.

Ha Long Bay takes its name from legend as the place where dragons descended to protect the Vietnamese people from invasion. Thousands of limestone islands scattered across the emerald sea, covered in thick forest conceal hidden caves, and provide shelter for colourful floating fishing communities. This breathtaking geographical and cultural jewel, steeped in folklore is Vietnam's most iconic UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Upon arrival at the jetty, proceed with check-in formalities around noon before being welcomed aboard. You will be served lunch while cruising the tranquil waters and will have plenty of time to take in the magnificent seascape of Ha Long Bay. Depending on your cruise itinerary, you will be able to enjoy activities either this afternoon or the following morning to explore caves and grottos, visit pearl farms, or take in picturesque island beaches. Some cruises also include kayaking. After sunset, enjoy a Vietnamese cooking demonstration before enjoying a delicious dinner. At the end of the day set anchor for the night among the karst formations.

Note:

- Please note your vessels itinerary is subject to change at short notice and is dependent on weather and tidal conditions. If weather conditions are deemed unsafe, the harbour master may deny departure and you will be re-accommodated with the best alternative ground services available.

Day 4: Halong Bay – Hanoi – Danang – Hoi An

Awaken your senses early this morning with a Tai Chi session on the sundeck or simply relax on board and take in the magnificent surroundings. Breakfast is served (brunch on some boats) while you enjoy cruising back through the bay. Upon disembarking your cruise, meet with your guide again and transfer in private vehicle to Noi Bai Airport in Hanoi for your flight to Danang.

Flight: Vietnam Airlines VN169 / Hanoi – Danang / 16:45 – 18:15 (Economy class)

Upon arrival at Danang airport, look for your tour guide holding a signboard with your name on it. Then meet with your driver for a 45-min private transfer to the hotel in Hoi An, the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town of the ancient port. This sublime riverside town is a feast for the eyes.

Meals:BrunchAccommodation:Hotel Royal Hoi An, Deluxe Room in Hoi An.

Day 5: Hoi An

Breakfast at hotel.

Located 30 km south of Danang, the sublime riverside town of Hoi An is a feast for the eyes. Without most forms of motorized transport, the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town of this ancient port is perfect for exploring on foot. Explore beautifully preserved old merchant houses, atmospheric temples, and lively markets as you stroll through the back streets of this enchanting destination. You'll visit the iconic 400-year-old Japanese Bridge and the busy waterfront, where colourful fishing boats bob up and down on the Thu Bon River. During the walk, make a stop at a market to taste well-known local green leaf cakes in Hoi An. Optional take a brief local boat ride along the Thu Bon River to see the ancient trading port from a different perspective. Wrap up the tour by visiting a Tea House that supports disadvantaged youth. The majority of the staff are hearing impaired, making for a unique experience as you communicate your order or tea or coffee or home-made cookies by writing it down or using wooden blocks with words.

- Operates: 08.00 - 12.00.

- Tour pickup from hotels located in Hoi An area. The Tea House's closure time at 17.00 on Sats & Suns - one unit/portion of tea or coffee or home-made cookies per person.

Day 6: Hoi An – Danang – Quy Nhon

Breakfast at hotel.

This morning you are transferred to Danang railway station for a fun train ride to Quy Nhon SE21/Dep 08:00 - arrival 14:03. Train ride by Reunification Express (local train)

Upon arrival, you will be picked up by Maia Quy Nhon's representative and transferred to the resort by shuttle minivan.



Remaining of the day is at leisure for relaxation.
